4 lifters were tested at the WEC and the analyzes of the samples show they are all negative.

4. Positive lifter at the European Masters Bench.

Matthew Mackey from Great Britain competed in the European Masters Bench in Luxembourg in October and his doping sample was positive by the forbidden substance of Stanozolol. Mackey competed in Master 2 category 120+ achieving second place. He is suspended for 2 years and his result at the championship is disqualified.

5. Doping control of European records.

According to IPF Antidoping Rules, all World record breakers in Sub-Junior, Juniors, Open and Master1 must be doping tested. Master II to Master IV record holders may be tested.

The same rule is valid for European records.

This means that if European records are broken at World championships and the lifter is not called for doping control, he/she must him/her self notify the doping controller and ask for a doping test. EPF will pay for the test.

6. EPF Award of Merits.

The French federation has ordered the EPF Award of Merits in silver to honour the following persons;

Stephane Hatot, Marc Duhem and Gèrard Hernandez for their long and good work for Powerlifting in their own federation. Congratulation!

7. National Antidoping report.

According to the IPF antidoping rules 14.2, all national federations must report their national antidoping activity in 2011 within 31 March 2012.

9. Greetings from the President.

I am pleased to see that only one lifter is found positive out from the totally 94 doping tests carried out at European championships in 2011. The total number of IC (in competition) tests carried out at European championships are lower in 2011 than previous years. But this is compensated with OC (out of competition) tests carried out by IPF.

Totally 49 OCTs have been carried out in 2011 and the majority was from European lifters.

No European sportsmen – independent of which sport they practice – are taken serious if they are not from a nation with high credibility regarding antidoping. A strong pressure is imposed by the WADA and IOC on former nations with low credibility regarding antidoping. In e.g. Russia, an intensive control is imposed by WADA testing many kind of sports (including powerlifting) with unexpected OCT tests in 2011.

EPF welcomes all initiatives that stimulate and control the credibility of the nations antidoping work. Good antidoping attitudes and controls are most effective done at national levels.

IPF is now working with an update of the IOC membership application which will be posted at the beginning of year 2012. But we all know that only a decrease in the number of positive powerlifters - at international as well as national level – is an undebatable requirement by IOC to grant IPF membership.
