1. The EPF General Assembly.

The EPF General Assembly took place in Sofia 6 May and delegates from 21 member nations were present. It was decided that from next year, European Classic powerlifting championships for Open, Juniors and Sub Juniors will take place for the first time.

It was also decided that every member nations participating with more than 3 lifters in an European championship must send at least one referee to avoid paying a fine of 500 Euro. Further, the final change of nominated lifters and referees is 14 days prior to the technical meeting (instead of the present 7 days).

2. Application for referee examinations.

When National federations put forward candidates for referee examinations, please use the following link

The application form can also be loaded down from the EPF web – " Services – Contracts –Forms".

Applications should be posted latest 3 months ahead of a championship.

The written category II examination is conducted by a computer program and each candidate may bring his own computer.

If the candidate do not master the English language, he must also bring with him a translator.

3. Nomination for European championships.

A new system is developed to make all National federations able to post their nominations directly.

Each President or Secretary General of the national federation must send request for login and password to Alexandre Kopayev. Each Federation will get only one password to login. The e-mail address is: goodlift@mail.ru and Alexandre will send you login and password to access the system.

That means that all nominations for European Championships should be done by the President or Secretary General of your National Federation.

Please note that federations must also send the nomination list to EPF Championship Secretary Jiri Hofirek and to Meet Director of each Championship. It is needed to make proper preparations for the Championships. If you need further information, you may contact the EPF Champion Secretary Jiri Hofirek.

8. Greetings from the President.

At the General Assembly in Sofia, a discussion regarding Classic European championships took place. The outcome was to start European Classic powerlifting championships for Open, Juniors and Sub Juniors from 2015. This will be a new championship meaning one extra Europeans each year. It was also discussed how to structure future European championships when Classic lifting is included for Masters and for Bench Pressers.

A solution could be to combine more age categories in one championship – e.g. Open, Junior and Sub Juniors in one championship for equipped and another championship for Classic. In Bench press, Open and Masters equipped in one championship and classic in another etc.

A proposal of a new structure will be presented at the GA 2015.

The World Classic championships in South Africa set a new record regarding number of participating lifters with more than 500 nominated. It was extremely long days for officials and organizers and the experience from this championship will be evaluated when EPF decide about the new championship structure.
