1. Greetings from the President.



Arnulf Wahlstrøm

The General Assembly in Pilsen summarized the activity of European powerlifting in 2018.

About 700 more lifters took part in European championships 2018 compared to 2017. This is a huge increase and shows that the sport is growing.

The economy is sound in EPF and organizers of European championships received last year from EPF equipment and economic support of about 50.000 € plus 30€ for each lifter taking part – meaning about 65.000€.

It is important to support our organizers because we expect and require championships of highest possible standard.

What is sometimes disappointing about European championships is that not all federations support the Opening ceremony. Representatives do not take part in the opening procedure, meaning the organizer must provide people to carry the country name poster and few participants attend in the audience.

Perhaps the Opening ceremony must be made more attractive or participation made obligatory?

Best is if we can stimulate the organizers to make the opening ceremony more attractive by including some kind of shows.

Some delegates at the GA expressed their frustration to decide 60 days prior to a championship the names of lifters to be nominated. The participation and anti-doping fees are based on the preliminary nomination, so they may risk to pay for lifters not able to take part. Nominating reserve lifters may partly solve this challenge, but not always.

From these discussions, the Executive committee will change the procedure from 2020.

Payment of participation and ant-doping fees will be based on the final nomination and reserve lifters not replacing preliminary nominated lifters will be allowed nomination.

Due to this, the reservation of accommodation will as well change. Only hotel bookings reserved and paid for 3 weeks (or date specified in the invitation) will be noted as championship

reservations. Participants booking their own accommodation may do so, but need to pay 100€ administration fee to the organizer.

2. Report from the EPF General Assembly 2019.

22 nations and 7 EC members attended the EPF General assembly in Pilsen 27 April.

3 new EPF officials were elected:

Bjorn Astad from Norway is new Championship Secretary, **Tero Hyttinen** from Finland is new chairman for the Law & Leg. Committee and **Silva Katutyte** is new member of the Finance Committee.



Silva Katutyte from Lithuania was elected New Auditor

Leaving were Jari Rantapelkonen and Thomas Högberg.

The work of Rantapelkonen and Högberg for EPF through many years is highly appreciated. Thank you to both!

Jiri Hofirek left as Champ. Secr. and was appointed EPF Ass. Secretary. This is a new position assisting


both the Secretary General and the Championships Secretary.

Referees must decide latest 14 days prior to the technical meeting if they accept their duties specified in the EPF referee list posted at the EPF web. The procedure is:

Available referee duties are to be nominated (by member federations) latest at the final nomination. Then the Technical chair makes up the list and post it at the EPF web. Any changes must be reported back to the Techn. chair latest 14 days prior to the technical meeting.

Any referee changes required at the technical meeting or later, will trigger a 100€ fine.

However, nations may change duties between their own referees latest at the technical meeting.

Another proposal that caused long discussions, was the fact that the hotel rack rate is sometimes raised during the competition and the EPF administration is not always able to correct this. Reasons are that any hotel may raise the rates up and down according to the demand.

Based on these discussions, the EC will work out new procedures for 2020.

Proposals accepted at the GA will be in power from 1. January 2020 if not otherwise stated.

3. EPF Hall of Fame awards 2019.

At the General Assembly, following persons were awarded EPF Hall of Fame:

Official: **Gaston Parage**, LUX
Female lifter: **Valentina Nelyubova**, RUS
Male lifter: **Hassan El Belghitti**, FRA

After the GA, it was known that Valentina Nelyubova tested positive in 2006 at the Bench Worlds and was suspended for 2 years.

According to EPF rules, no one who have been sentenced for doping abuse shall be awarded Hall of Fame.


EPF EC has then decided to disqualify Valentina Nelyubova the title of Hall of Fame.




